Associate

(adopted at AGM 7/5/12)

Explanation

There are some members of KCC who remain keen supporters but who are not able to be at the Convention in May for various reasons. This means that they cannot attend the Annual General Meeting (AGM) which is always held on the convention weekend. Potentially this could mean that the AGM might struggle to get a quorum (30% of current members).

These members want to remain supporters in prayer and by being kept informed, but they do not want to cause quorum problems at the AGM.

To solve this problem, the amendments create a new class of member, called "Associate".

"Associate" will be "a person who supports the Objects and purposes of the Association but is unable to attend General Meetings".

Members who cannot get to AGMs can transfer to this new class of membership, if they want to.

Associates have all the rights and responsibilities of a member **except to be counted in the AGM quorum and the right to vote at an AGM**. They will need to apply in writing to become associates and agree to the objects and purposes of KCC (if they haven't already done so). They will still receive all notices of meetings and related papers and pay the annual fee.

They will be able to transfer back to ordinary membership at any time if their circumstances change and it turns out they can now attend AGMs.

APPLICATION TO BECOME A MEMBER OR ASSOCIATE OF KCC

6. The bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ from the dead, and His ascension to the right hand of God the Father.
7. The necessity of the work of the Holy Spirit to make the death of Christ effective to the individual sinner, granting him/her repentance towards God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.
8. The justification of the sinner by the grace of God through faith in Christ alone.
9. The indwelling and work of the Holy Spirit in the believer.
10. The one, holy, universal Church, which is the body of the Lord Jesus Christ, and to which all true believers belong.
11. The expectation of the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ, at which time the dead in Christ will be raised to be with Him.
